Champagne

Bottle

Champagne originates in the Champagne wine region of Northern France, making sparkling wines of quality, distinction and finesse, becoming associated with Royalty in the 17th, 18th, and 19th centuries.

Moët & Chandon Brut Impérial (Vegan) 200ml

£18.00 £82.00

First produced in 1860's this shows great elegance and complexity with notes of brioche, cereal and fresh nuts.

Laurent Perrier La Cuvée (Vegan)

£90.00

The first independent family Champagne House and is still as progressive today in style and outlook. Fresh and complex palate, with notes of honeysuckle, ripe peach, citrus and a slight toasty note on the finish.

Bollinger Special Cuvée Brut (Vegan)

£90.00

The wine made famous by Ab Fab but quality abounds with 85% of the fruit sourced from Grand and Premier cru vineyards. Aromatic complexity with aromas of ripe fruit and spices: notes of roasted apple, compote and peach and layers of creamy toast.

Laurent Perrier Cuvée Rosé Brut (Vegan)

£130.00

Sourced from ten of the top Champagne crus this is an absolute delight- A fragrant nose of fresh strawberries, raspberries and palate of ripe red currants and black cherry with a rounded elegant finish.

Dom Pérignon Brut 2009 (Vegan)

£280.00

The first vintage of Dom Pérignon was 1921. It is a vintage champagne and only made in the best years, being cellared for at least eight years before released to the market - one of the best Champagnes produced?

Prosecco has become the Sparkling wine of choice for sipping on the sun terrace or pre dinner, but English sparkling wines have increased dramatically in quality over the last ten years and now give even traditional sparkling wines a run for their money.

Moinet Prosecco Brut DCG (Vegan) Veneto – Italy 200ml £9.00 £42.00
Delicate aromas of acacia blossom, wildflowers, yellow apples and exotic fruits.
A well balanced, refreshingly light Prosecco.

La Tordera Prosecco DOC Rosé (Vegan) Veneto – Italy 125ml £10.00 £45.00
Pink Prosecco with notes of citrus, strawberries and cream. Summer fruits, redcurrants and raspberries with a hint of white flowers.

Cremant de Bordeaux ‘Clemence’ Bordeaux – France 125ml £11.00 £52.00
Aged in bottle for 9-12 months producing a beautifully light yellow colour, with golden highlights and perfumed bouquet of citrus fruits combining with delicate floral notes.

Balfour ‘Leslie’s Reserve’ Brut (Vegan) Kent – England £50.00
Prestige English sparkling from the original owner of Liberty’s in London, where excellence is the norm! – complexity of flavour, elegant with bright citrus notes with orchard fruit and spice.

White Wine

175ml 250ml Bottle

Dry, Refreshing, Delicate and Light. Delicately flavoured, crisp and generally dry with a minerality and crisp finish – ideally suited to fish dishes, shellfish light meats and salads.

Pinot Grigio 'Folio', Cantine Minini Trentino - Italy £9.00 £11.00 £33.00
Light on the nose with hints of citrus. The palate is expressive yet delicate with notes of pear drops and white flowers.

Picpoul de Pinet, Chemin des Dames (Vegan) Languedoc - France £39.00
Notes of citrus fruits, grapefruit, and flint mingle with a hint of herbaceous on the finish. Produced on the Mediterranean coast and an ideal partner to shellfish and oysters.

Les Courtines Côtes de Gascogne Gascony - France £35.00
A blend of 60% Sauvignon, 20% Gros Manseng and 20% Colombard highly aromatic notes of cut grass and green peppers with the Gros Manseng adding notes of stone fruit, and citrus.

Albarino Pazo de Villarei (Vegan) Rías Baixas - Spain £42.00
Lovely and crisp in the mouth with a balanced citrus and red apples, marine acidity and hints of almonds on the finish.

Zesty, Herbaceous and Aromatic. Wines from around the world that are ideal to partner white fish, poultry and lightly spiced dishes.

Chenin Blanc: Riebeek Cellars Swartland - South Africa £8.00 £11.00 £28.00
Herbaceous and fresh offers tropical undertones of gooseberries, passionfruit and pears.

Vinho Verde, Zela Casal Ventozela Minho - Portugal £8.50 £12.00 £36.00
Founded in 1983, this is a family-run winery, dedicated to the production of Vinho Verde. Aromas of fresh apple with floral notes of orange blossom, citrus and a slight spritz with refreshing acidity.

Two Points Sauvignon Blanc Western Cape - South Africa £33.00
Fresh and zesty with notes of grapefruit and green apple flavours with a light and fruity palate.

Roero Arneis, Villadoria Azienda Piedmont - Italy £48.00
From the hills of Piedmont, this is the Queen of white Italian wine – delicate, aromatic, subtle, perfumed with notes of peach, almond and yellow apples.

Kaituna Sauvignon Blanc Marlborough - New Zealand £9.00 £13.00 £38.00
Nautilus Estate; a small, family-owned winery began in 1985 and now produce award winning wines. Passionfruit and cut grass, citrus and tropical fruit dominate the clean, refreshing palate.

White Wine

Sancerre Blanc: Domaine Durand Loire - France £56.00
Loire Sauvignon at its best, with notes of green bell pepper, cut grass and passion fruit. Lively and refreshing with a clean, mineral finish.

Juicy, Fruit driven and Ripe White Wines. Rich in body with sufficient weight and fruit to balance strong flavoured fish dishes, creamy poultry and spiced dishes.

Verdejo El Quinto Paraje (Organic) Rueda - Spain £42.00
Fresh citrus with the hint of a herbaceous note on the nose. The palate has ripe stone fruit, grapefruit, fennel and lime notes, with subtly integrated oak adding vanilla notes and a creamy texture.

San Felipe Pinot Gris Mendoza - Argentina £8.50 £12.00 £32.00
A richer, more overtly fruity take on Pinot Grigio with a lovely ripe peach and melon flavour, balanced with a lingering finish – produced by Rutini Wineries who boast some of the best wine from Argentina.

Horizon Chardonnay (Vegan) Limoges - France £39.00
Subtle white floral and citrus Chardonnay from Southern France, produced by a renowned Burgundy house – with a touch of vanilla on the finish.

Full flavoured, Nutty, Oaked white wines. Complex with rich full flavours, yet balanced with lively fruit -European styles are best to match with food as they are subtler in the mouth with lingering flavours.

Pouilly Fuisse. Laurent Perrachon Burgundy - France £55.00
Full bodied with creamy white orchard fruit, apricot, peach blossom, elegant, dry with a lingering finish.

Lacrimus Rioja Blanco Rioja - Spain £32.00
Produced with the rare 100% Tempranillo Blanco with 20% of the wine aged in barrels – producing delightful notes of tropical fruit, floral and toasted nuts, silky in the mouth.

Rose Wine

Rosé wine is now drunk all year around and no longer the semi – sweet in style, with the Southern French wines being hugely fashionable, Provence leads the way in style, quality and finesse.

Ca'Maritta Pinot Grigio Blush Veneto - Italy £7.50 £9.50 £28.00
Delicate crisp, dry rosé with white peach, citrus and red fruits flavours.

Big Top Zinfandel Rosé California - USA £8.50 £10.50 £31.00
Bright pink in colour with notes of raspberry and cherry on the nose. Off sweet with candied fruit, sweet cherry & strawberries.

Etoile de Mer Rosé (Vegan) Pays d'Oc - France £9.00 £12.00 £38.00
Beautifully balanced fresh, dry Southern French rosé with delicate pink grapefruit, wild raspberry flavours with fresh citrus notes.

Mirabeau 'Classic' Provence Rosé Provence - France £12.00 £16.00 £45.00
Elegant on the nose, electrifying and rich, with aromas of cherry, vineyard peach, apricot, orange zest and freesia. A hint of strawberries and cream.

Red Wine

175ml 250ml Bottle

Juicy, Medium bodied, Fruit led reds. Fruit driven with gentle medium bodied supple flavours – great with lighter meats and tomato-based sauces, along with poultry, salmon and vegetarian dishes.

Rubino Principe Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Abruzzo - Italy £7.50 £9.50 £28.00
Medium bodied with subtle ripe cherry and redcurrant fruit with a slight savoury finish.

Whistling Duck Cabernet / Merlot Riverina - Australia £29.00
Aromas of plum and blackberry on the nose. The palate is medium bodied displaying blackcurrant, cherry and plum jam flavours.

Feudo dei Venti Nero d'Avola Sicily - Italy £30.00
Lovely lingering flavours of plum and black cherry with hints of tomato leaf, liquorice and sweet peppers.

San Felipe Barrel Selection Malbec (Vegan) Mendoza - Argentina £9.50 £13.50 £39.00
In 1925, Rutini Winery became the first to plant vines in the Uco Valley, the top wine-producing regions in Mendoza. Silky, richly bodied, packed with ripe dark fruit with just a touch of vanilla and spice.

Pinot Noir 'Les Planches' Pays d'Oc - France £8.50 £11.00 £31.00
Aromas of cherry, blackberry and raspberry on the nose. A concentrated and fruity palate silky and rich on the palette.

Red Wine

Lacrimus Rioja 5 (Vegan) Rioja - Spain £9.00 £12.00 £34.00
Sweet, dark ripe fruit, expressive, creamy & luscious- rose, cherry, red pepper and truffle. Previously voted best Spain's best winery with wines from a superb wine maker.

Beaujolais Village Laurent Perrachon Beaujolais - France £42.00
Lively and fresh with floral hints of violet. Soft and fruity on the palate with notes of pomegranate, blackberry and cherry.

Spicy, Peppery, Warming reds. Richly fruit driven with damson, sweet pepper and black olive notes – ideal to partner with rich meat dishes.

Primitivo Appassimento 'Linteo' (Vegan) Puglia - Italy £8.00 £11.00 £30.00
Plums, black cherry and ripe strawberries on the nose. The palate is rich, full-bodied, silky with concentrated notes of plums-in-brandy, blackberry and dried herbs.

Valpolicella Ripasso 'Casa al Pruno' (Vegan) Verona - Italy £9.00 £13.00 £38.00
Verona's best kept secret? Richly silky, medium bodied but subtle with a heady palate of damson, cherry and kirsch.

Valde Syrah Reserve Swartland - South Africa £42.00
Subtle New World Syrah with loads of rounded red fruits, hints of spice and dried herbs but so smooth and lingering on the taste.

Chateau Barre Gentillot l'Orangerie Bordeaux - France £48.00
Located near Saint Emilion, Château Barre Gentillot flies the flag for this unsung Appellation, with its roundness, body and finesse. Subtle red fruits, cedar and velvety texture – delicious!

Three Bridges Shiraz Barossa Valley - Australia £45.00
Barossa Valley produces some of the best Australian Shiraz -oodles of stewed fruit aromas and a hint of spice with complex notes of leather, liquorice, and black pepper.

Sophisticated, Polished, Complex Reds.
Classic style wines with great depth of flavour, beautifully balanced with long lingering flavours.

Meerlust Red, Meerlust Estate (Vegan) Stellenbosch - South Africa £55.00
A fantastic wine from the famous Meerlust Estate, rich, rounded deep red fruits velvety texture with warm spice, vanilla and damson fruits – blend of Merlot, Cab Sauv and Cab Franc!

Chateau Franc Pipeau, St Emilion Grand Cru Bordeaux - France £75.00
The vineyard dates back to 1680. The Bertrand family has upheld its passion for vines and wine for five generations. A very beautiful, brilliant, intense wine, complex nose and palate marked by fresh fruit and slightly toasty notes.
